- Based on requests from faculty members wishing to open courses, the departments will determine the courses to be offered.
 - The identified courses will be submitted to the relevant Faculties/Schools to enable course merging between departments/programs.
 - Faculties/Schools will notify other relevant Faculties/Schools of courses to be merged between units.
 - Decisions of the Faculty/School Administrative Boards regarding course merging will be communicated to the relevant units.
 - External quotas for the opened courses will be determined.
 - If there are courses that need to remain open despite not meeting the minimum required student quota, a decision of the Administrative Board must be obtained and submitted to the University Administrative Board.
 - Course schedules must be entered into the automation system.
- All of the above steps must be completed by **15 June 2026**.

The Faculties/Schools must inform the Student Affairs Office by 8 June 2026 about which unit will be responsible for opening the common compulsory courses.

As of **15 June 2026**, the system will be closed for course opening and closing transactions. Courses that need to be closed after the first course registration period must be processed for closure **between 4–5 July 2026**.

If there is a schedule conflict between the courses selected by the student, the automation system will not allow registration for those courses.
